



DISPOSING OF HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTES

Some of the products you use at home are potentially hazardous. Safe handling and proper disposal of these materials will protect you, your family and our environment.

The following materials require special handling and should be disposed of at a household hazardous waste collection event.

Acetone	Hydrochloric Acid	Paraquat
Arsenic	Insecticides	Pentachlorophenol
Boric Acid	Kerosene	Paris Green
Chlordane	Lead	Photographic Chemicals
DDT	Lighter Fluid	Rust Remover
Dieldrin	Malathion	Solvents
Fertilizers (liquid)	Mercury	Swimming Pool Chemicals
Formaldehyde	Muriatic Acid	Turpentine
Gasoline	Paint Stripper	Varathane
Herbicides	Paint Thinner	Wood Preservatives
